- Construction of new overhead electrical infrastructure to approved standards;
- Completion of overhead maintenance tasks in a timely manner and in accordance with Yarra Trams business objectives;
- Reporting on overhead maintenance inspections and ensuring data is clear & accurate;
- Inspection, testing, and maintenance of tools & equipment as required;
- Fault investigation & analysis

What you will need for this role

To be successful in obtaining one of these apprenticeships, you will have:

- A strong desire to attain the required qualifications and experience to complete the apprenticeship via both TAFE and experience gained at work;
- A strong interest in the maintenance and construction of overhead electrical assets;
- A desire to work in an outdoor environment;
- A strong work ethic;
- Ability to work at heights;
- Basic Safety Knowledge;
- Current Victorian driver's licence (preferable);
- Knowledge of Road Safety (Traffic) Regulations particularly relating to tram operations (preferable);
- Please note that this role will be on a continuous rotating shift roster.
